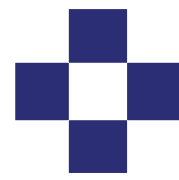
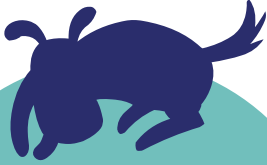

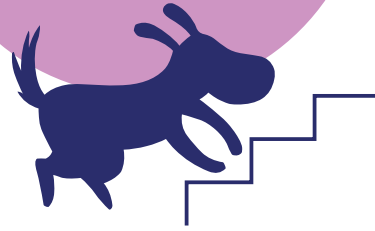


DECREASED ACTIVITY

The Most Common Signs of

Pain in Your Pet

DIFFICULTY STANDING AFTER LYING DOWN

is a sign of osteoarthritis



OVER GROOMING OR LICKING A PARTICULAR AREA

can be a sign of referred pain



DECREASED APPETITE

this can signal mouth pain
